## PCN ALLIED HEALTH CLINICIANS are part of your clinic team

Richmond offers this robust, multidisciplinary team of Primary Care Network (PCN) allied health care professionals, who work with you and your patients in team-based care

#### **Clinical Pharmacists**

- conduct medication assessments
- ensure prescriptions are suitable for each condition
- provide advice on dosage and adverse reactions

#### Chronic Disease Management Nurses (RNs)

- provide mild to moderate chronic disease information, care, and monitoring (diabetes, heart disease, COPD, high blood pressure, high cholesterol)
- support the adoption of healthy lifestyles
- offer problem-solving and self-management skills
- conduct chronic disease prevention education

#### **Dietitians**

- provide nutrition consultation and assessment
- support patients in adopting healthy eating habits
- prevent, delay, manage chronic conditions
- patient education around nutrition needs
- help patients make sustainable lifestyle changes

#### **Group Education Sessions**

- chronic disease self-management skills taught in small group settings
- support patients and caregivers
- · available in multiple languages

#### **Mental Health Counsellors**

- provide support for anxiety, depression, life changes and adjustments, interpersonal conflicts, and grief/loss
- introduce tools to cope with personal issues
- help patients to gain new perspectives

#### **Occupational Therapists**

- conduct psychosocial assessment to support informed decisions about benefits
- connect clients to resources/ applications
- support system navigation for factors that impact patient health: finances, housing, social supports
