This is an excellent opportunity for a physician looking for a stable, rewarding locum arrangement with potential to grow into a practice-share or full panel transition.

Practice Overview

- **Location:** 230-7360 Westminster Hwy, Richmond, BC (dedicated on-site parking included)
- **Practice type:** Solo family practice within a collegial shared clinic space (two other experienced family physicians on site)
- **EMR:** Med Access
- **Patient panel:** Approximately 2,100 (with plan to downsize to 1,800), consisting of multigenerational community families, 60:40 female:male, with a younger adult (30–50) and sizeable pediatric population. English-language practice.
- **Clinic hours:** 4.5 days/week, 6 hours of direct patient care per day
- **Coverage required:** One day per week (consistent, long-term) starting in Fall/Winter 2026
- **After hours/on-call:** None

- Established, stable patient panel consisting of community patients who have been with the practice 5+ years
- Evidence-based, up-to-date clinical environment with regular CME engagement
- Physician-managed practice with full financial transparency. No third-party or corporate management
- Collegial clinic environment: two other family physicians on site who are welcoming and available for assistance
- Host physician is locally available and accessible for questions, case discussion, or mentorship as needed
- Opportunity for mentorship in longitudinal practice management for those newer to independent practice

Compensation & Overhead

A flat 25% overhead rate applies to all billings (MSP, WCB, ICBC, and private). This rate is set to cover actual clinic operating costs only; there is no profit markup. Remittance reports are provided and payment is issued promptly.

For a committed long-term locum or practice-share partner who assists with panel management, patient panel attachment payment split can be discussed.

Dr. Sun graduated from the University of Ottawa School of Medicine (2016) and completed her family medicine residency at UBC (2018). She has been in full-time longitudinal family practice for eight years, practicing at her current Richmond location since March 2025.

Dr. Sun serves on the Richmond Division of Family Practice Board of Directors and is a clinical instructor at UBC. She is pursuing expanded leadership and teaching roles, which is what is prompting this locum opportunity. Her patient panel and practice infrastructure remain fully intact and thriving.
